- Speeding on E Glebe Road and Montrose Avenue
- Cut-through traffic on Montrose Avenue and other internal streets
- Complexity and visibility issues at Glebe/Montrose/Ashby intersection
- Drivers not stopping for people crossing the street
- Narrow sidewalks

- ✓ Glebe/Montrose/Ashby long-term intersection improvements

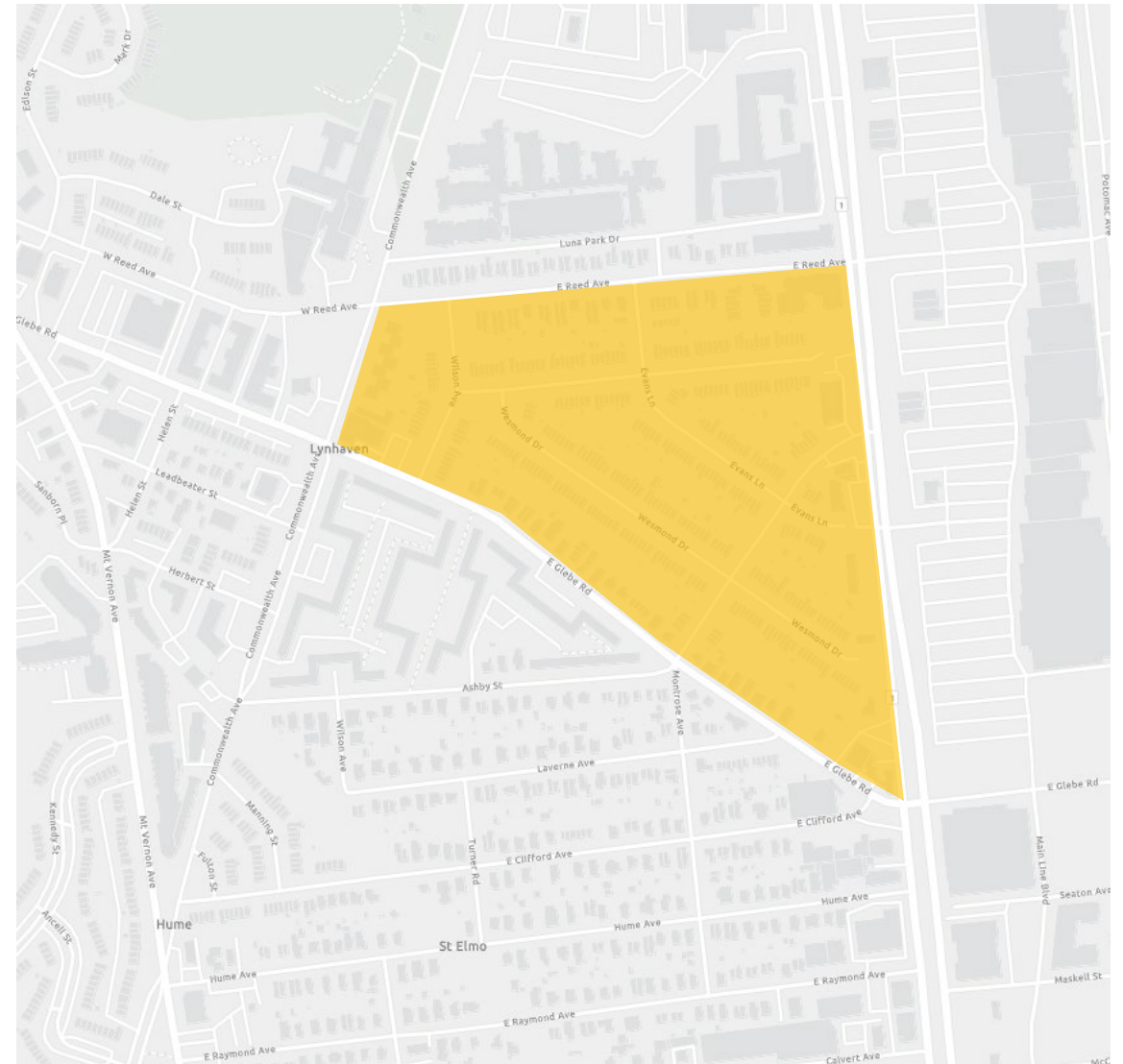
# Neighborhood Slow Zone

## Potential Improvements

- Gateway treatments at entry points
- Speed cushions
- Crosswalks
- Mini traffic circle near park

## Updates

- Design consultant in procurement
- Design expected to begin early 2022



# Glebe Road Speed Management

- Speed radar signs at regular intervals on Glebe Rd
- Updates:
  - Signs are in procurement
  - Installation in 2022





# Glebe Road Crossing Improvements

---

- Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacons (RRFBs) to be installed for uncontrolled crosswalks across Glebe Rd at intersection with Montrose & Ashby
- Updates:
  - Signs are in procurement
  - Installation in 2022

# Glebe/Montrose/Ashby Intersection Improvements

- Upcoming stormwater capacity and green infrastructure project
- Coordinated effort to integrate transportation improvements with the stormwater project
