Background

2

- Earlier Identification and Prioritization of Stream Issues – City's Phase I&II Stream Asst. (2004, 2008) identified and Phase III Stream Asst. prioritization (2018-19)
- 2018 – Applied for Stormwater Local Assistance Fund (SLAF) Grant for FY 2019 to improve the health of our streams and protect City infrastructure.
- January 2019 – Begin stream restoration projects outreach
- March 2020 – COVID (impact to messaging but work continued)

September 2020 Reboot of Public Communications

- ▶ September 2020 – General public and ‘Small Expert Group’
- ▶ April 2021 - Council pauses projects; EPC collaboration on alternative designs
- ▶ October 2021 – Institute for Engagement and Negotiations (IEN) to assist with community consensus building
- ▶ February/March 2022 – IEN interviewed stakeholders and staff
- ▶ March 2022 - IEN presented community engagement process to EPC for consensus; created Stakeholder Advisory Group (SAG) around EPC
- ▶ May 2022 - Report produced by IEN of stakeholder interviews
- ▶ May – August – Staff met regularly with IEN to finalize next phase scope and schedule
- ▶ Today – Next phase forward with Consensus Building Group (CBG); September 10th is the first public workshop through fall/winter

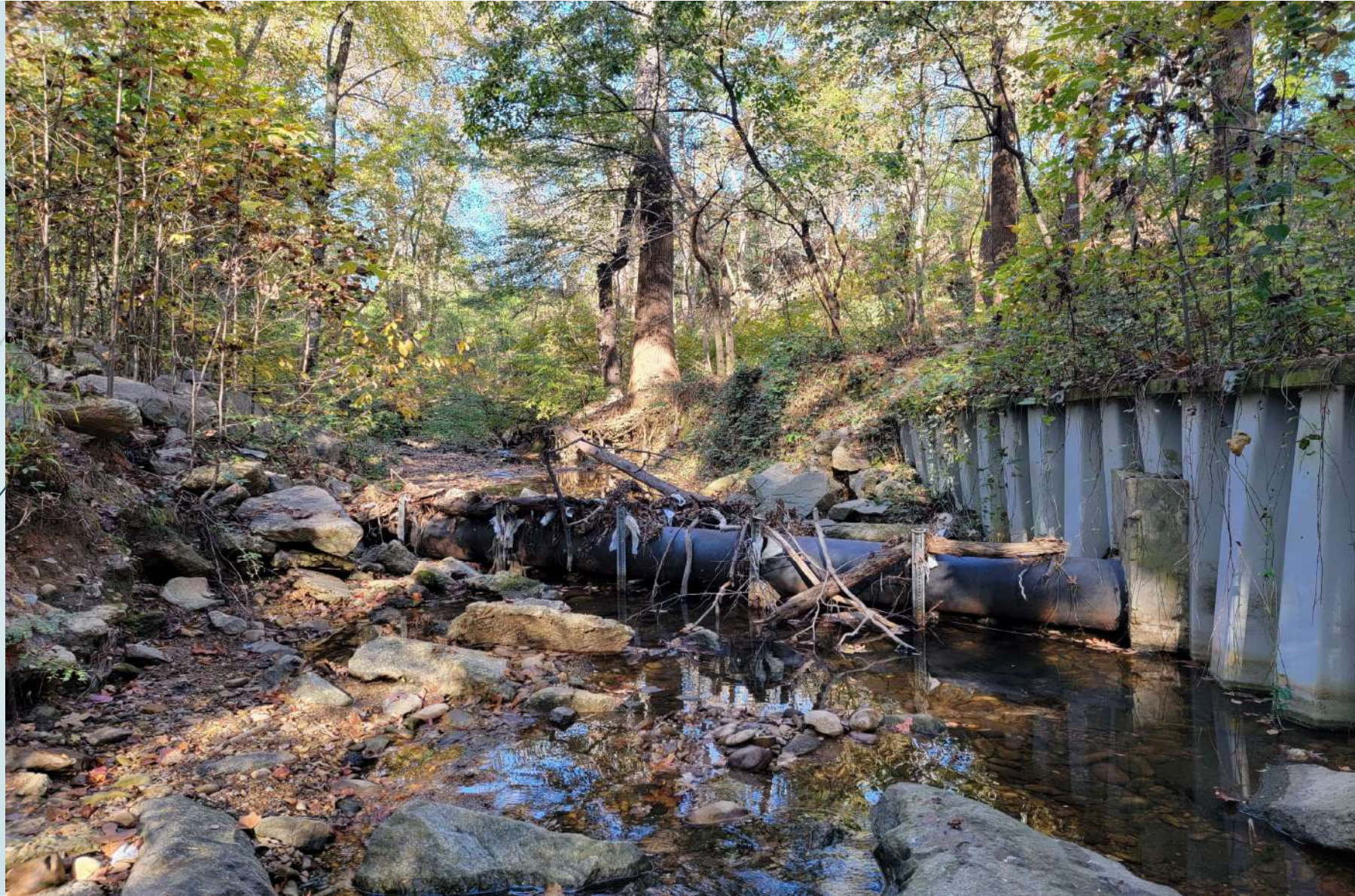










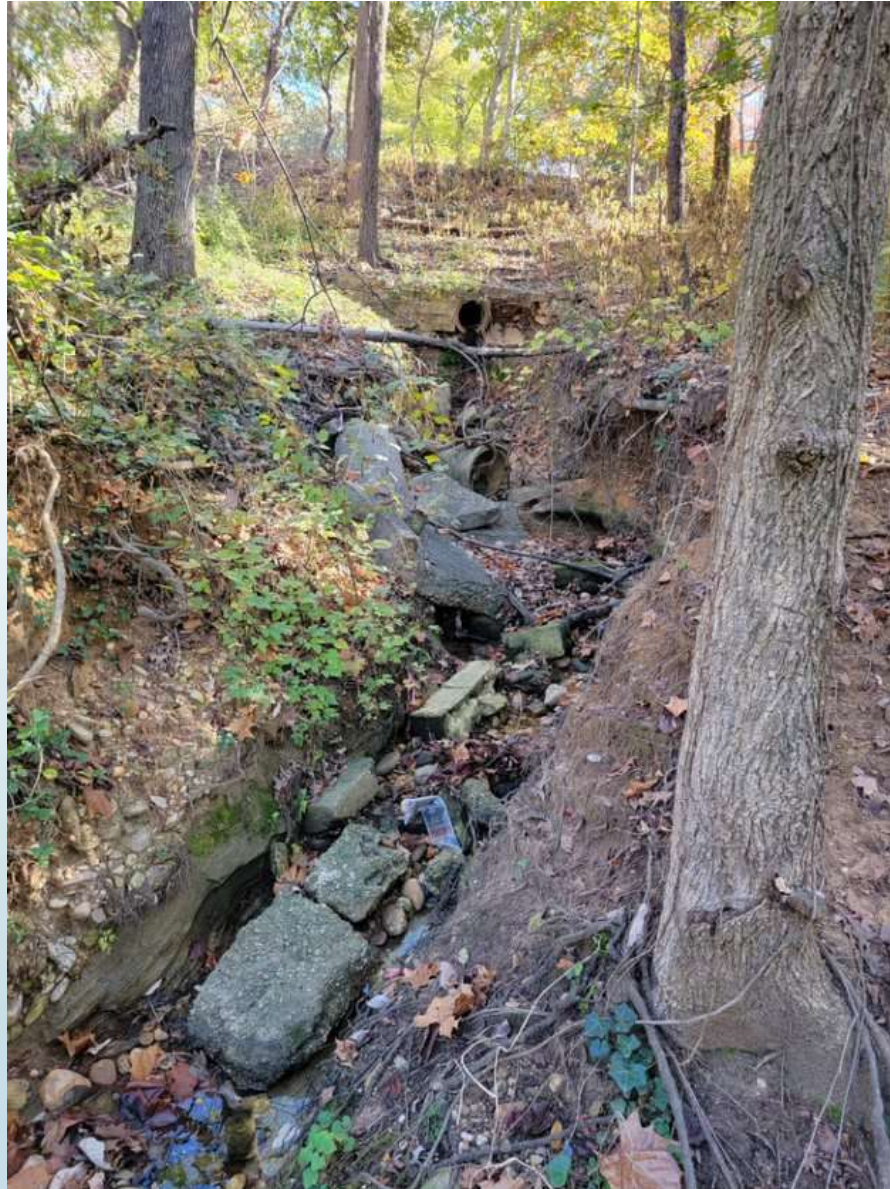




Strawberry Run Existing Conditions

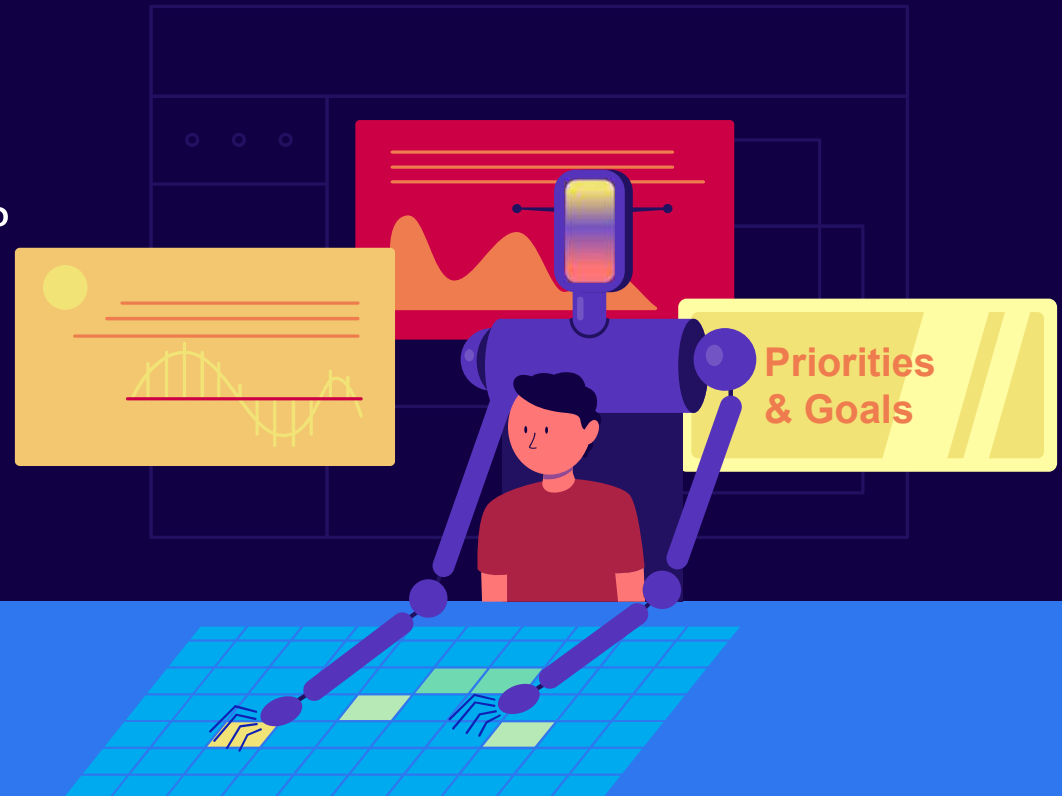
