About The Pilot

The City is working through two pilot projects aimed at reducing regional cut-through traffic on neighborhood streets and shifting traffic onto the major arterials. To do this, we also must improve the flow of traffic on the arterials and make those routes faster than cutting through the neighborhoods.

Pilot Goals

- Reduce congestion on Duke St.
- Reduce cut-through traffic on neighborhood streets.
- Use data to inform decisions about long-term projects.
- Improve the quality of life for residents.

What This Means for You

No access from West Taylor Run Parkway onto the Telegraph Road Ramp from eastbound Duke Street. Please use alternate routes and prepare for increased travel time.

Get Involved

The City is advancing a variety of initiatives to improve transit along the Duke Street corridor. This includes a number of projects underway that address community priorities such as reliable transit, improved safety, and keeping Duke Street moving for all vehicles.
