In response, the Alexandria LGBTQ+ Task Force submitted a letter to City Council requesting a resolution reaffirming support for the City's transgender and non-binary students. The CYFCC discussed their response, which is to write a letter to Governor Youngkin, incorporating information from the LGBTQ+ Task Force's meeting.
