## We want your input!

The City of Alexandria is launching a project to improve safety and access near William Ramsay Elementary School.

The project map shows proposed improvements in this area. This includes recommendations that were made through the Safe Routes to Schools Program.

In addition, the City recently reduced the speed limit on North Beauregard Street to improve safety. The posted speed limit was reduced from 35 to 25 miles per hour, and the school zone speed limit was reduced from 25 to 15 miles per hour.

Project design is expected to begin this fiscal year. Staff will continue to engage with the community throughout the project to gather feedback.
