

GREEN STREET SIDEWALK PROJECT



The City of Alexandria has a planned project to install a sidewalk on the south side of Green Street, between South Royal Street and South Fairfax Street.

This project was identified as a priority sidewalk gap in the adopted Alexandria Mobility Plan.

This project would:

- Give people in the neighborhood a safe, dedicated place to walk
- Improve access to the community garden and Jones Point Park
- Improve safety and access for families walking to or from school
- Support the City's adopted Alexandria Mobility Plan policy of creating a complete sidewalk network
- Visually narrow the street and calm vehicle traffic

Project design is expected to begin this fiscal year. During the design process, staff will continue to engage with the community and identify what, if any, impacts there may be, such as to parking, drainage, or vegetation.
