- Delegation also heard from ITS, P&Z and TES re: broadband in the City

4. Digital Equity Action Plan (Dana Wedeles)

- Survey has been out for approx. three weeks.
- PRR has attended many pop-up events throughout the City.
- Survey closes on 12/22.
- RA: How has survey been going with non-English speakers? We don't have numbers yet but haven't heard of any issues.
- SD: How are we getting phone numbers to call for survey? From the partner organizations.
- PRR has asked us for assistance with two items: review the list of questions for the participant screener and review the focus group moderator guide.

Participant Screener

- SD: Should we not dismiss people who have good internet access, use them as a control group? DW: PRR recommended taking these people out, there are other ways to hear from them.
- TC: How does PRR differentiate between the City of Alexandria and the other Alexandria addresses? DW: Using zip codes and community organization knowledge.

- RA: Will calls be placed in all four languages? DW: Yes. Spanish calls will be handled by PRR, Arabic and Amharic calls will be handled by Computer CORE.
- SK: Why are they asking how they identify? DW: To get a proper mix of diverse individuals.
- Discussion around 'household' vs. 'family unit'.
- TC: Are we looking to make distinction between literacy vs. technology? DW: Yes, this will be valuable information.
- SK: Is it necessary to ask for income before taxes? This can be confusing. DW: Agrees that this is confusing.
- A Google doc will be set up to take input/comments

Focus Group Mediator Guide

• A working session will be held on January 12, 2023 to discuss this guide. A Google doc will also be available beforehand to take input/comments.

5. Open Data

- TC created a draft resolution re: open data.
- Staff and committee members share some feedback.
- There was a conversation around social impact, user anonymity and data availability.
- TC will take the info from the discussion and edit the draft.

- SD: Commission charter rewrite to better reflect what the Commission does.
