

(a) Public hearing of issues regarding the construction of the Verizon Fiber Optic Service (FIOS) in the City of Alexandria

Based on Ordinance No. 4599 (June 13, 2009), Verizon Virginia Inc. entered into a 25-year agreement to design, construct, maintain, and operate a telecommunications system, excluding cable services, for the benefit of residents, businesses and government in the city.

(b) Response from the City on Executive Order #24 from Governor Youngkin

Governor Youngkin enacted Executive Order #24 on December 16, 2022 which indicated that "No person shall access TikTok or WeChat or any other application developed by ByteDance Limited or Tencent Holdings Limited through Commonwealth owned, operated, or maintained wireless network." The Executive Order indicated that "the Virginia Information Technologies Agency is directed to restrict access to these websites and applications in accordance with this Executive Order."
