5. Presentation and Discussion

- (a) Discussion about Alexandria City Public School (ACPS) data privacy
 - Data exposure in January 2023, family contact information.
 - The leak was from a web server from Blackboard Connect, a vendor which ACPS had stopped using in June 2022.
 - The information was down about 40 minutes after contact with Blackboard Connect.
 - An engineer had made a misconfiguration and exposed multiple school systems' data in December 2022.
 - ACPS has created a new data privacy agreement for vendors as a result of this incident.

6. Open Data

- The Committee had a reading of the draft document and decided on various options for language, unanimously approved.
- Draft will be going to City Attorney's office.

7. City Deliverables

- (a) Renewal of Cox Telecom License Agreement
 - City Attorney's office: Cox has requested additional time. Motion to postpone this discussion unanimously approved.

8. Other Business

- **a)** Public hearing of issues regarding the construction of the Verizon Fiber Optic Service (FIOS) in the City of Alexandria
 - Working with representatives from City Attorney's office and T&ES for this meeting to discuss.
 - Steve Chozick: Need clarification of why we are bringing Verizon in. What will be discussed?
 - Sara Crifasi: The initial ask was to find out what Verizon is doing, per the franchise agreement. Not sure we need them to meet with them in a public forum.
 - There is no intent to single out a single vendor.
 - We would like Verizon report on what they are currently doing in the City, as we have done with prior vendors.
