

# March 6, 2012 Presidential Primary Fact Sheet

**Voting Hours 6 a.m. - 7 p.m.**

On Tuesday, March 6, 2012 there will be Republican Presidential Primary Election in Virginia. Polling places in Alexandria will be open from 6 a.m. to 7 p.m. (There will be no Democratic Presidential Primary because only one candidate, Barack Obama, met the state's filing requirements.)

## Voter Registration Deadline is Monday, February 13

Applications must be postmarked by Monday, February 13, or dropped off at the Voter Registration Office by 5:00 p.m. on 2/13.

- Applications are available at the Voter Registration Office, DMV Centers, City Hall, Alexandria Public Libraries or online at the Virginia State Board of Elections ([www.sbe.virginia.gov](http://www.sbe.virginia.gov)).
- Upon request, applications will be mailed or faxed.
- The Voter Registration Office is open Monday – Friday from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.
