Beyond Consent: Healthy Sexuality & Sexual Violence Prevention focuses on the primary prevention of sexual violence. Traditional sexual violence prevention work has focused on the reduction of risk factors by potential victims of sexual violence. This focus, on risk reduction factors such as avoiding certain situations, awareness of surroundings, self-defense, etc, frequently results in victims being blamed for the sexual violence. Primary prevention is a change to a focus on preventing the violence by concentrating on changing the behaviors of potential perpetrators of violence. The concepts in this workshop will promote the development of sexually healthy individuals in a sexually healthy society as the key to preventing sexual violence.
