Enclosed is registration information regarding the Department of Recreation, Parks and Cultural Activities Winter 2010 Adult Sports Volleyball and Basketball League Programs.

- Each league has a posted deadline and maximum number of teams. League registration is closed on the posted deadline date, or if the maximum number of teams are reached prior to the posted deadline.
- Teams will be accepted when the following information and league fees, including nonresident fees, are received before the close of business on the deadline date:
 1. Team roster information must be prepared on the roster form provided. Returning teams must submit a new roster on the form provided within this package.
 2. Teams are required to submit an email address that can accept file attachments.
 3. Teams must submit two points of contact.
 4. Teams must submit payment by check or money order, no cash. **TEAMS MUST SUBMIT ONLY ONE CHECK PER TEAM.**

Please Note: Registration information may be submitted without player signatures, but a final roster with signatures must be filed in the Adult Sports Office prior to the first scheduled game.

- Leagues are formed by divisions, and are divided by skill level and the primary day of the week on which games are played. Although each division is scheduled to play on a specific weeknight, teams will be required to play on other nights for the scheduling of make-up games and play-offs.
- In the event the league, skill level, or night of week for which your team has registered is full or does not have enough registrations, recreation staff will contact the team manager. Team managers will be given the option to play in a different league, skill level or night of week. The Department of Recreation, Parks and Cultural Activities reserves the right to place teams in a skill level based on past team performance. Teams will not be moved without first consulting the team manager.
- Team managers or a team representative is required to attend the preseason manager's meeting. **Please note the date of the managers' meeting on the registration information sheet.** Schedules will be distributed, and rules and regulations will be discussed. Meeting information, including schedules, will not be sent via fax, email or by mail to teams missing the manager's meeting.

2010 WINTER COED VOLLEYBALL INFORMATION

FRANCHISE FEE: \$450 (No cash accepted). Make checks or money orders made payable to "City of Alexandria".

NONRESIDENT FEE: \$25 for each player living outside the City of Alexandria. Please see enclosed Zip Code Chart for residency.

ROSTER: Limited to a maximum of 6 men and 6 women, and a minimum of 4 of each. Changes in roster may be made through January 31, 2010. A \$25 nonresident fee must accompany the written change if an added player lives outside the City of Alexandria.

DEADLINE: December 11, 2009. A team will not be accepted unless franchise fee, nonresident fees, and a team roster (with names, addresses and phone numbers) are all submitted by December 11, 2009. **Please Note:** A player who works in the City must still pay the nonresident fee if such player lives outside the City of Alexandria.

LEAGUE PLAY: Starts week of January 4, 2010 and runs through March (including playoffs).

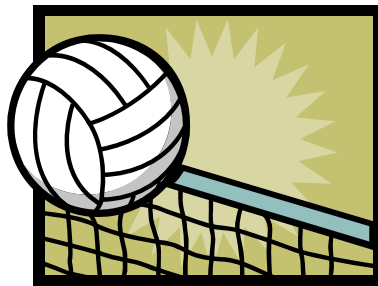
LEAGUE SCHEDULE: 10 match regular season. A match consists of the best of three rally point games. Games 1 & 2 will be 25 rally point games, and game 3 (tiebreaker) will be a 15 rally point game. A one (1) hour time limit will be in effect for all matches. Whichever team is ahead by at least 2 points when time expires wins the game. Minimum of the top four teams in each division advance to the league playoffs. **USAV Rules Apply.**

EQUIPMENT: Teams must furnish their own uniforms.

LEAGUE FORMAT: "Competitive" and "Recreation". The **Competitive Division will play on Wednesdays and the Recreation Division will play on Tuesdays.** All Divisions may play matches on Monday if necessary. **Please Note:** The Department of Recreation, Parks and Cultural Activities reserves the right to place teams in a skill level based on past team performance. Teams will not be moved without first consulting the team manager.

MANDATORY MANAGERS' MEETING: Thursday, December 17, 2009, 8:00 p.m., at the Lee Center, 1108 Jefferson Street. The Adult Sports Office will not provide league schedules by fax or email. It is required that all teams send one representative to the managers' meeting.

FRANCHISE FEE: \$650 (No cash accepted). Make checks or money orders made payable to "City of Alexandria".

NONRESIDENT FEE: \$25 for each player living outside the City of Alexandria. Please see enclosed Zip Code Chart for residency.

ROSTER: Limited to a maximum 12, and a minimum of 8. Changes in roster may be made through January 31, 2010. A \$25 nonresident fee must accompany the written change if an added player lives outside the City of Alexandria.

DEADLINE: December 11, 2009. A team will not be accepted unless franchise fee, nonresident fees, and a team roster (with names, addresses and phone numbers) are all submitted by December 11, 2009. **Please Note:** A player who works in the City must still pay the nonresident fee if such player lives outside the City of Alexandria.

LEAGUE PLAY: Starts week of January 4, 2010 and runs through March (including playoffs).

FRANCHISE FEE: \$650 (No cash accepted). Make checks or money orders made payable to "City of Alexandria".

Registration Priority Policy

- Teams registering before the established deadline date for each sport league will be accepted, up to the maximum number of teams per league, as follows:

First priority will be given to teams comprising 60% City Residents;

Second priority will be given to teams meeting the 90% affiliation rule (90% of team members must be either City residents, employed full time in the City, be a member of a recognized City civic group, or a member of a church within the City limits); and

Third priority will be given to all other teams.

- All teams, regardless of their affiliation, will be charged an additional \$25 per nonresident, over and above the established league fee.
- When the maximum team limit is reached before the posted deadline, registration will be closed.
- After the posted deadline date, teams will only be accepted if space is available. Teams registering under the First and Second Priority Classification must provide proof of residency or affiliation at the time of registration.

Proof of residency may be verified by the player's's driver's license, utility bill, lease or rent contract, City of Alexandria tax assessment or City of Alexandria Voter Registration Card.
