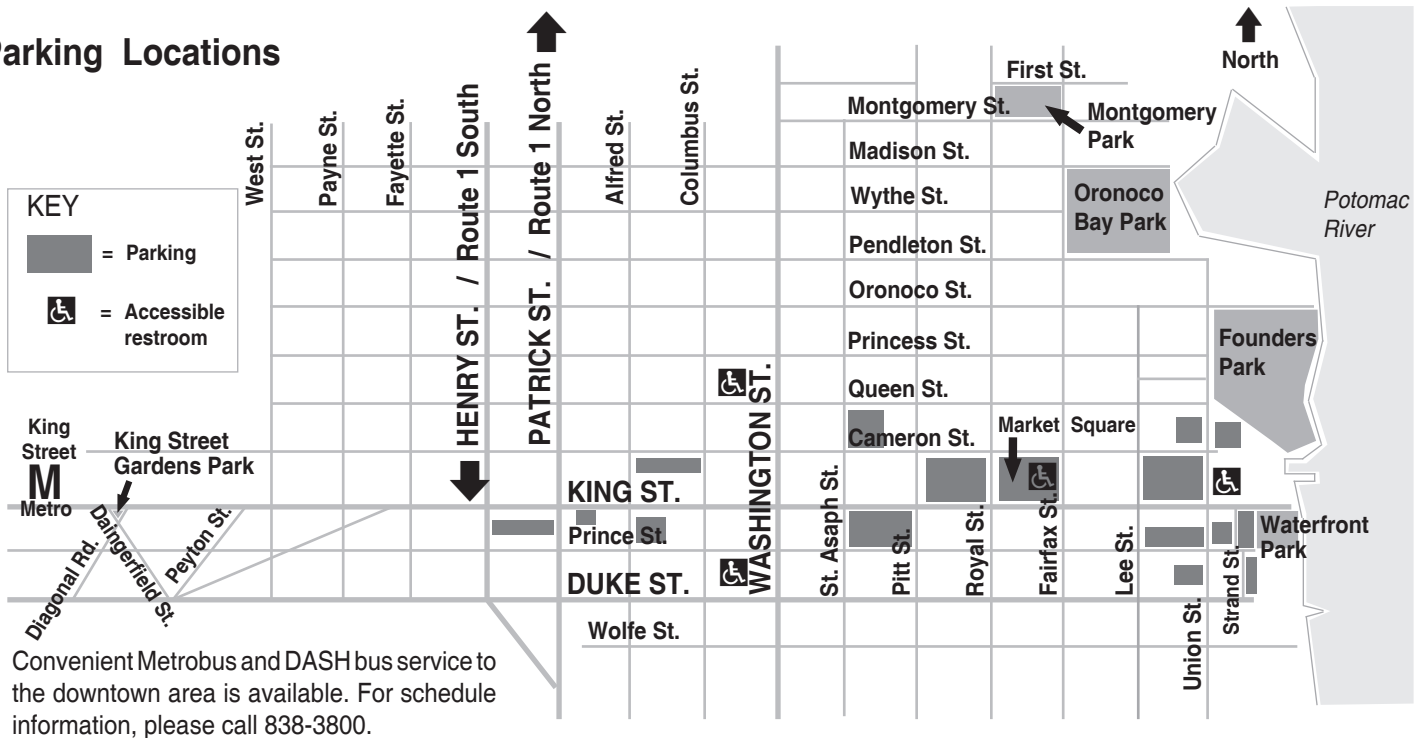


WHERE TO PARK IN OLD TOWN
