

Ad Hoc Scooter Task Force

In 2019, City Council approved Phase II of the Pilot Program. At that time, City Council also established the Ad Hoc Scooter Task Force. The Task Force's mission was to provide guidance to City Council regarding a structure for scooters and other forms of micromobility that would address the community's concerns regarding these devices within the City right-of-way. Staff were tasked to meet with the Task Force to discuss the future of the program in Alexandria. Due to the COVID-19 health emergency, City Council extended the Phase II Pilot Program through 2021 to allow the Task Force time to convene. The Task Force met several times in 2021 to craft recommendations; those recommendations were shared with and approved by the City Council in November 2021 and resulted in the creation of a permanent dockless mobility program in Alexandria.
