

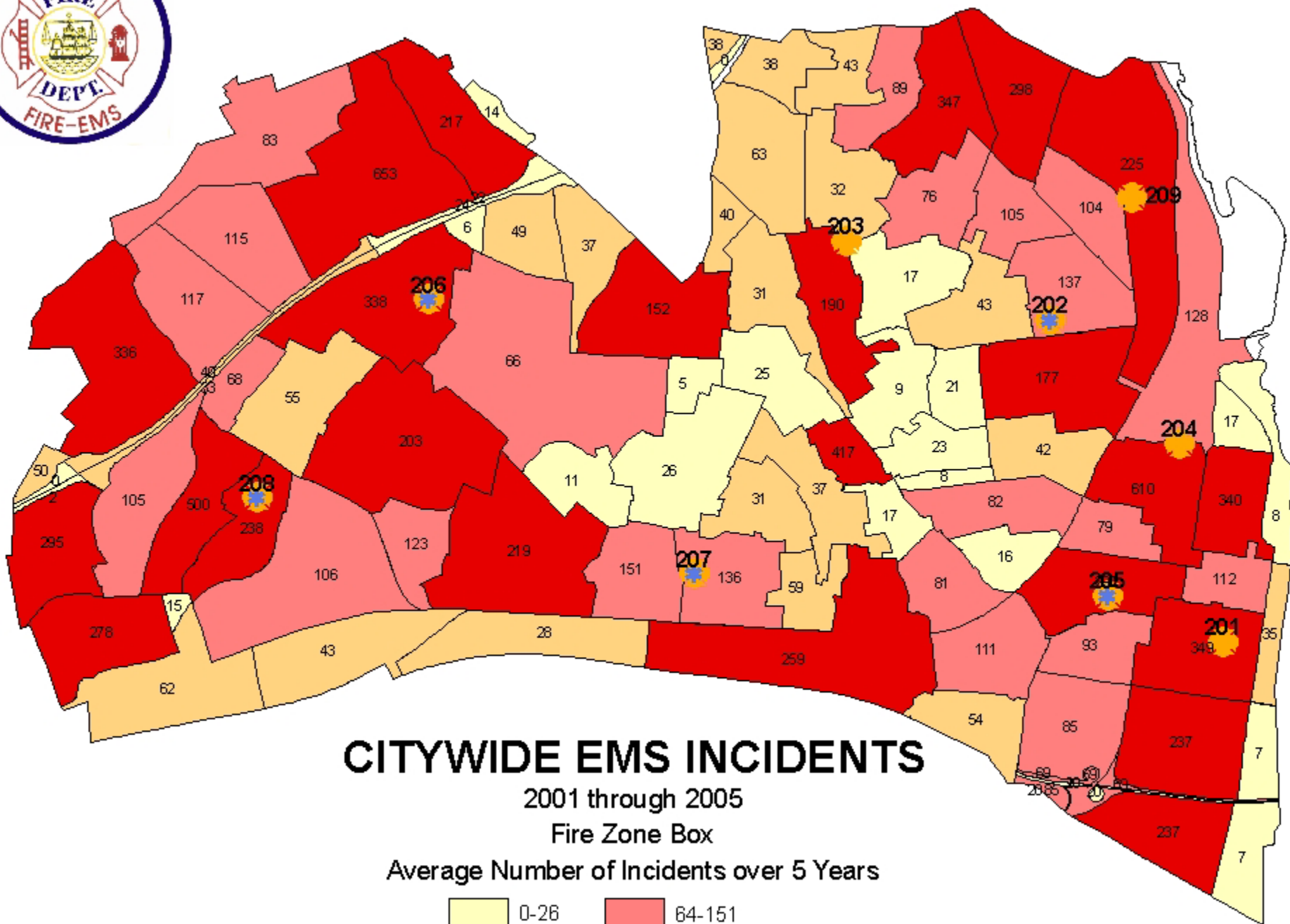

ZONE BOX MAP**



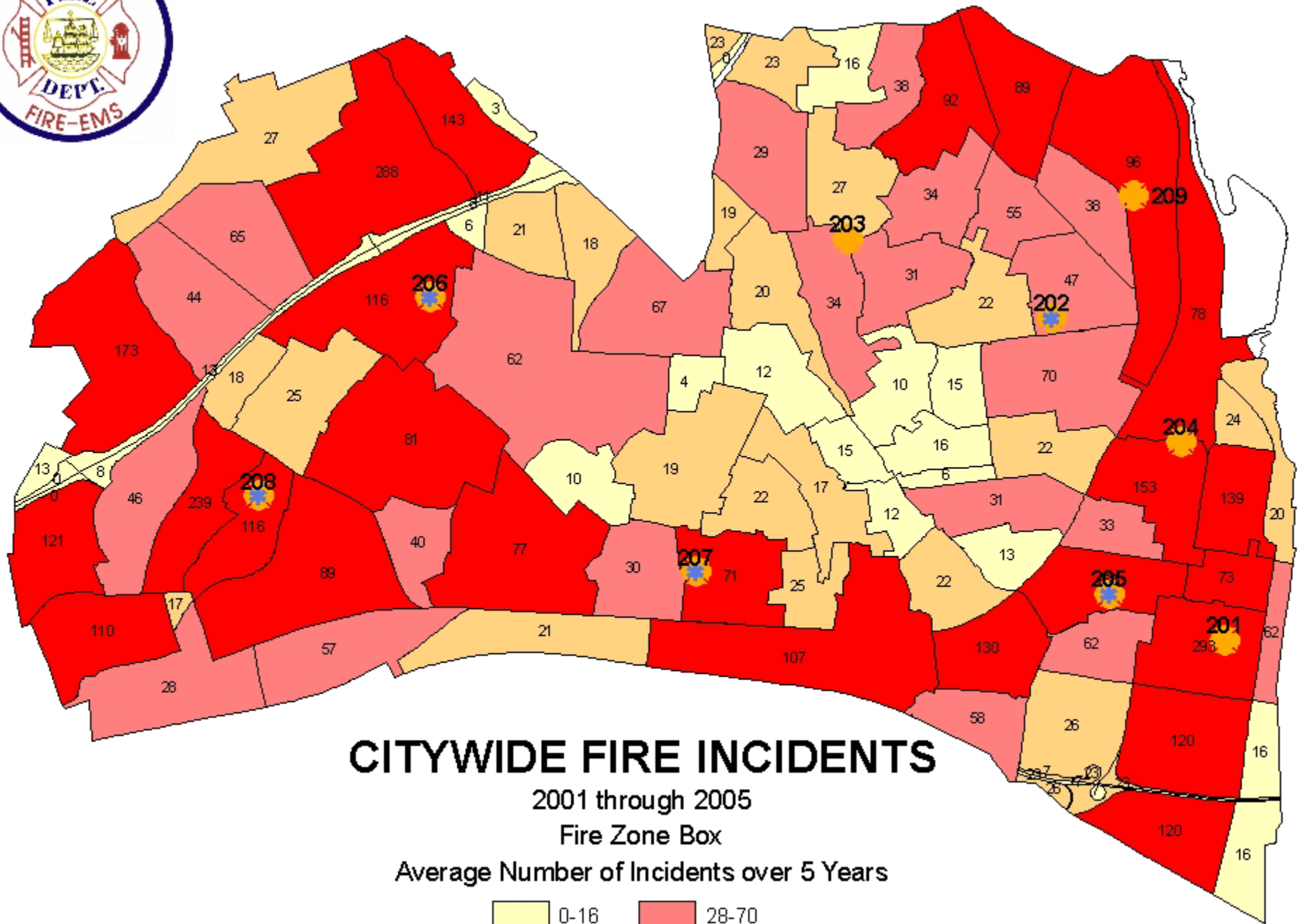
CITYWIDE EMS INCIDENTS

Average Number of Incidents over 5 Years



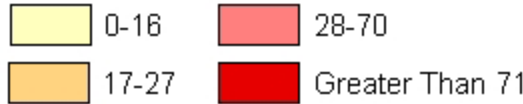

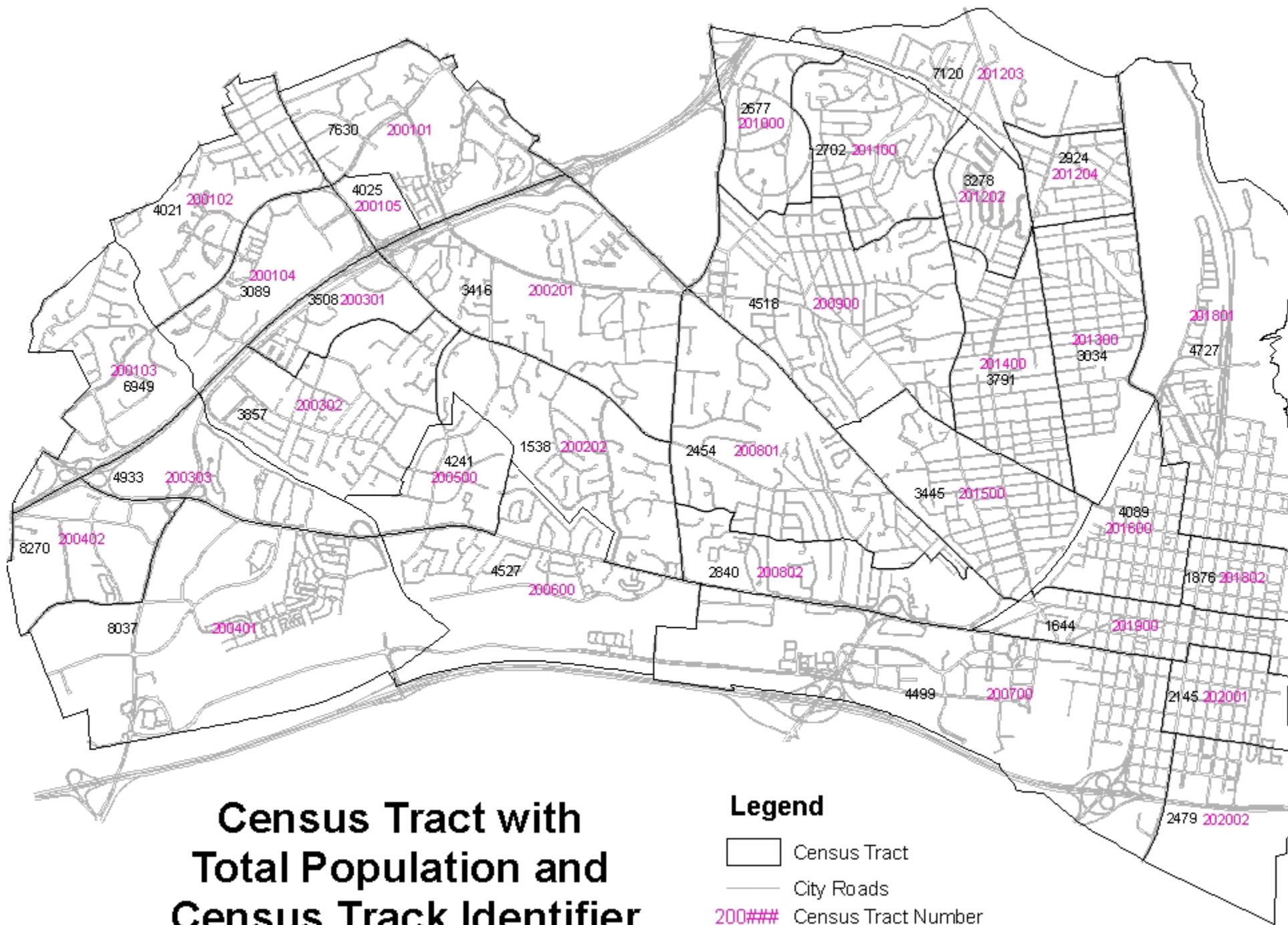
