



Alcohol Awareness Month Scavenger Hunt Instructions

The Substance Abuse Prevention Coalition of Alexandria (SAPCA) encourages youth to be safe and substance-free year-round. In recognition of Alcohol Awareness Month this April, SAPCA has created a fun scavenger hunt for middle and high school youth. Youth that participate in the scavenger hunt will receive a SAPCA swag bag and another fun activity to enjoy at home.

Read on to learn how to *play* – and don't *delay*! The only way you will benefit from prizes *galore* is if you submit your answers *before* the contest *deadline*, *Friday, May 6*.

Scavenger Hunt Steps for Success:

1. Read each clue one at a time. Each clue describes a location in the City of Alexandria. Feeling stumped? Consider asking a friend or family member for help to find the correct answers.
2. Once you have answered a clue, you can either take a selfie at the clue's location or find a picture of the location online. If you decide to visit a location in-person, please follow [local COVID-19 guidelines](#). Before visiting any location in-person, make sure you have permission from a parent or guardian.
3. Repeat steps one and two for as many clues as possible! Can you solve all six clues?
4. Send selfies and the pictures you found online using one of the following methods:
 - Email photos to April Pavis-Shroeder at april.pavishshroeder@alexandriava.gov with the subject line "SAPCA Scavenger Hunt." Your email should also include your first name, grade, and the school you attend.
 - Text photos to Emma Beall at 571.302.1022. In your text, include your first name, grade, and the school you attend.
5. All participants are eligible to receive a SAPCA swag bag and another fun activity to enjoy at home. For each clue you correctly solve and send a picture of, you will be entered into a raffle for the grand prize: a \$50 Target gift card.
