4% Margin of Error



Modal Share of the Work Commute




Average **percent of total work trips** made by via Each Mode




Work Commute – Effect of Pandemic

Little or no change in the amount I work from home	30%
I now work from home fewer days of the week	7%


Main Reasons for Driving to Work






Barriers to Walking


There was more street lighting after dark

Barriers to Biking


I do not want to use a bicycle as a means of transportation

My travel time was less than if I used a personal vehicle


There were routes that stop at my desired destinations

There were routes that stop at or near my home


Services were more frequent


Services were more reliable







Factors Influencing Mode Choices












Transportation of School-Aged Children




