

# **Planning Process for the CYCP 2025**

  - Engaged 2,117 community members, 88% of which were youth, to learn more about the concerns, hopes, and dreams that Alexandrians have for its young people




- Identified the most important issues effecting Alexandrian youth

### Youth Role in Phase III


- Determined priorities

- Creating and enhancing positive relationships between youth and adults


