
### Background

- Pilot to remove parking on the east side of Cambridge to facilitate traffic at this location.
- 2 parking spaces on the east side were left in place during the pilot



## Proposal

- Remove up to 5
   parking spaces on
   Cambridge Rd
- Maintain 2 3-hr spaces in front of 255 Cambridge Rd



#### Recommendation

That the Board recommend removal of up to five (5) parking spaces on the east side of Cambridge Road south of Dartmouth Road





#### Council Discussion on Parking Actions

- 1. Expansion of the Residential Pay-by-Phone Area
- 2. Adjusting Residential Pay-by-Phone Rates
- 3. Adjusting Parking Garage Pricing to Incentivize Use

- 4. Split Residential Permit Parking District 1 into Two Smaller Districts
- 5. Residential-Only Parking Restrictions

# Residential Pay by Phone - Current Program



- Approved on 18 blocks
- Parking fee is \$1.75/hr

Average block collects~\$1,300 a month

### Incentivizing Garage Usage


 Proposed Resolution allows staff to establish parking rates in garages, lots, and Residential Pay by Phone blocks up to a maximum rate of \$5/hr

#### Potential adjustments:

- Different parking rates at different times of day, or on different days of the week
- Changing the hourly rate at garages to be less than the hourly rate at the meter (\$1.75).
- Charging different rates for different garages
- Charging higher rates at residential Pay-by-Phone blocks to encourage parking at the meter or in the garages



#### CY 2021 Garage Occupancy - All Garages



### Process for Changes

- Notify Traffic and Parking Board of changes prior to implementation
- Annual review with Traffic and Parking Board to assess changes

#### Recommendation

The Board recommend the City Council:

- 1. Approve the Ordinance
  - amending the Residential Pay-by-Phone program and
  - clarifying that pricing for Residential Pay-by-Phone areas and metered lots is set by Council resolution; and
- 2. Approve the Resolution allowing the Director of T&ES to establish rates for parking garages, metered lots, and Residential Pay-by-Phone blocks.
