## Quarantine Length for Household Contacts in DAYCARE with Continuous Exposure

Jo and Sam are siblings under the age of two and unvaccinated. They both attend Happy Kids Daycare. Jo tested positive for COVID-19 on 1/17. Jo does *not* have symptoms. Sam tested negative for COVID-19 on 1/17 and does *not* have symptoms.

When can Jo return to daycare? Jo should isolate for 10 days. Jo can return on 1/28. When can Sam return to daycare? Sam is continuously exposed to Jo from 1/15 through 1/22. Sam's quarantine begins on Day 6 of Jo's isolation period. Sam should quarantine for 10 days. Sam can return on 2/2.
