The purpose of the draft Practical Updates is to:

1. Codify certain provisions of the approved <u>2020/21 Housing Contribution Policy</u> that relate to rezonings involving increases in density; and

2. Memorialize certain existing housing policies and practices specific to <u>Section 7-</u> <u>700</u> and clarify existing language.

As part of 1. above, the Updates propose to move the policy recommendations into the Zoning Ordinance and add definitions specific to Independent Living and Auxiliary Grant funded units for the purposes of Section 7-700; the Updates <u>do not</u> propose to modify the provisions of the 2020/21 Policy, such as the applicability, affordability provisions, or exemptions request criteria set forth in the Policy.

As part of 2. above, the Updates propose to clarify and streamline existing Section 7-700 language specific to levels of affordability, unit type and equivalency to memorialize existing practices; the Updates <u>do not</u> propose any changes to the levels of optional bonus density or height available through the SUP process.

These amendments to Section 7-700 are separate and distinct from those being considered through the Bonus Height <u>Study</u>, and are not being proposed to go to hearing before the fall.
