Overview






- Office dates to 1619 when constitutional officers were created by the House of Burgesses
- Elected city-wide to an eight-year term.
- Over 800 duties in Virginia Code: land records, probate of wills and trusts, oaths of office, marriage licenses, courtroom clerks, et al.
- In 2020-21, collected \$16 Million in real estate taxes and fees and transferred it to the city, and \$800,000 in other fines and fees.


