Chair Report

Introduction

Block 32 Task Force

Authority of City Council

- Determine policy in the fields of planning, traffic, law and order, public works, finance, social services, and recreation;
 Appoint and remove the City Manager;
- Adopt the budget, levy taxes, collect revenues, and make appropriations;
 Appoint and remove the City Attorney;
- Authorize the issuance of bonds by a bond ordinance;
- Appoint and remove the City Clerk;
 Establish administrative departments, offices, and agencies;
- Establish administrative departments, orlices, and agencies, Appoint members of the Planning Commission, and other City authorities, boards, commissions, and committees;
 Inquire into the conduct of any office, department, or agency of the City and make investigations into municipal affairs;
 Provide for an independent audit; and

- Provide for the number, titles, qualifications, powers, duties, and compensation of all officers and employees of the City.



City Manager



The Alexandria City Manager is appointed by the City Council to be the chief administrative officer of the City. The City Manager carries out the policy directives of the City Council and manages the daily operations of City government.

The City Manager oversees the preparation of the annual operating and capital budgets, an annual report and other such periodic financial and administrative reports as may be required for submission to the City Council. The City Manager appoints all heads of departments and employees of the City, except those in elected, judicial and school positions.


