- 1. <u>Call to Order and Roll Call:</u> All present confirmed their attendance.
- 2. <u>Approval of Previous Meeting Minutes:</u> Ms. Buttar made a motion to approve the minutes. The motion was seconded, and members approved.
- 3. City Council Opening Comments: None.

6. <u>Task Force 3 – 5 year plan Action Plan:</u> Chairman Dillion read the vision and mission statement. The vision: Safety, Support, and Opportunity for All, and the mission statement: Create a gang free community through collaboration, community outreach and advocacy.

Ms. Torres reviewed developmental assets and stated that developmental assets are a framework as in what framework do we want for gang prevention. Ms. Buttar reviewed local data related to youth and developmental assets and discussed the top 40 developmental assets.

7. <u>Chairman's Report:</u> Chairman Dillon proposed meeting an additional time this year to keep up momentum. Mr. Mackey explained that historically the Gang Prevention Community Task Force meets the third Wednesday of October, January, March, and May and offered October 19 as a suggestion.

Chairman Dillon proposed that the Gang Prevention Community Task Force champion three efforts: increased funding for IPE for additional staff in order to reduce their waitlist. The Chairman volunteered to write a letter to City Council requesting additional funds. He will share
