1. Introductions and Welcome

2. Approval of May 19, 2022 Minutes: unanimous (motion by SM, seconded by SD) with request by RA to add link to Ting presentation to website.

3. Update on City's Fiber Backbone Project (Patrick Eze and Steve Chozick)

- Updated map was shared.
- 8.37 miles of conduit has been installed since the last meeting, there is 8.12 miles to go.
- 24 handholes installed since the last meeting, 469 to go. Continuing supply chain issues have slowed down install.
- Conduit and handholes scheduled to be completed by August 2024. Fiber install and splicing scheduled to be completed by August 2025. Go-live is TBD.
- RA: Does the City plan on building new entryways to the City building? Smail: It depends on in if building is new, old or leased. There already is plan for each building.
- CS: Will fiber in Potomac Yard area extend to Arlington line? Smail: There currently is a connection where Glebe Rd., Richmond Hwy and Potomac Ave. meet for NCRnet connectivity.
- CS: Do we have an overall fiber map of the City? Steve Chozick is going to look into putting one together.

4. Digital Equity Committee Update (Catharine Rice)

- As part of the City's Digital Equity Plan, Computer CORE received funding for a Help Desk for citizens. Computer CORE also recycles donated computer hardware.
- A consultant has been hired to decipher broadband needs in the City, focusing on citizens to may not otherwise get noticed.

5. Cybersecurity/Disinformation Committee Update (Stephen Morris and Steve Davidson)

- CISO has left City employment. City IT is currently recruiting for a new one.
- It is possible to do a closed portion of a meeting to discuss sensitive topics if needed.
- SM: will find out if there is a City channel available for sending out IT security tips.

6. Charter Rewrite Committee Update (Catharine Rice, Chris Soghoian)

• Committee is currently working on a draft, updates to follow soon.

7. New Business (Catharine Rice): Manager's letter to commissions requesting feedback

- Network/cybersecurity monitoring is needed.
- From Vanetta Pledger: There is no dedicated staff for municipal broadband project. Also in need of hardware, someone to manage the franchise agreement, and a digital navigator to work with Ting.
