A collaboration between Alexandria City Public School Elementary School Artists and Art Teachers, the Alexandria Black History Museum, and the City of Alexandria.


#### It Starts with Me! Creating Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr's Beloved Community

- This year's concept is inspired by the King Center's 2023 Martin Luther King, Jr. Day Theme, which spotlights King's idea of a Beloved Community.
- The Beloved Community was a term first coined in the early 20<sup>th</sup> Century and later popularized by civil rights leader, Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr.
- Dr. King's Beloved Community is the idea that all people can share in the wealth of the earth. In the Beloved Community, all people are cared for, with no poverty, hunger or homelessness. Racism and discrimination will be replaced by an all-inclusive spirit of sisterhood and brotherhood. In the Beloved Community, disputes will be resolved through peaceful conflict-resolution and reconciliation. Love and trust will triumph over fear and hatred.
- We asked our ACPS elementary art students to create art that shows what they can do to create MLK's Beloved Community.


