




Project Goals



Create efficiencies



Implement typical recreational uses and park safety



Implement approved plans

Summary of Amendment



- Update the definition of park to include a diversity of uses;
- Update the definition of congregate recreation facilities to include congregate uses;
- 3. Update building and structure heights to 30 feet before a requiring a Special Use Permit to better reflect current open space uses;

Summary of Amendment



- 4. Permit standardized accessory uses and structures of parks;
- 5. Permit pathway and parking lot lighting for safety; and
- 6. Update the uses requiring a Special Use Permit to reflect the above changes

Project Timeline

- March: Public engagement
- April: Public Hearing at the Virtual Open Space Steering Committee meeting
- April: Public engagement findings and edits to text amendment
- May: File text amendment application
- June: Planning Commission and City Council hearings
