

## Phase I Community Feedback – At-a-Glance


## AlexWest Plan Transportation Study Methodology

- Evaluate traffic operations based on existing conditions and future land use projections in the AlexWest area
- 15 study area intersections
- Intersection analysis of delay and queuing
- AM and PM peak hour conditions
- Test three different land use scenarios:

Phase Two Goals Content:


- Use community feedback to develop high level draft plan themes and objectives for community review (May)
