2023-24 Power-On School Year Program Pre-Registration Eligibility Form



In accordance with the City of Alexandria's Social Equity initiative, the Department of Recreation, Parks & Cultural Activities' (RPCA) Power-On School Year Program is offering pre-registration for families who qualify for federal assistance programs (Free or Reduced school meals, SNAP or TANF). RPCA is offering the Power-On School Year Program for elementary school aged youth, enrolled in Kindergarten – 6th grade in Fall 2023. Pre-registration opens June 12 and ends June 17. Families will be notified of their eligibility via email or by phone beginning June 21. General online only registration begins June 28 at 9am (online only). In-person and online registration begins June 29, until all openings are filled. Pre-registration forms can be completed online or completed on-site at one of the neighborhood recreation centers or Summer OSTP locations during regular program hours.

The afterschool program begins Monday, August 21, 2023 and ends Friday, June 14, 2024 from 2:30 p.m. to 6 p.m. at Charles Barrett, Charles Houston, Mount Vernon, Leonard "Chick" Armstrong, Patrick Henry, and William Ramsay Recreation Centers, and John Adams, Ferdinand T. Day, and Douglas MacArthur Elementary Schools.

Program Registration Fee: \$792

Financial Assistance Fee: \$305 with documentation for free/reduced school meals

\$255 with Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) \$149 with Temporary Assistance to Needy Families (TANF)

A pre-registration period is provided for Alexandria residents who qualify for financial assistance. Alexandria residents interested in participating are required to verify eligibility by this pre-registration process. This process does not register your child for the program. If your child is eligible for the program, you will be notified by email and/or phone. Eligible families must submit payment and complete the full registration packet prior to starting the program.
