## NEIGHBORHOOD MEETING – December 2022

### Flood Action Alexandria Neighborhood Improvements Four Mile Run Park on December 20, at 6:30 PM

This notice is to inform City of Alexandria residents in the immediate proximity of proposed drainage improvements at 1) Edison Street’s Cul-de-Sac, 2) the 100 block of W. Reed Avenue, and 3) adjacent to Dale Street Community Garden of a public meeting to discuss planned stormwater improvements as part of the Flood Action Alexandria Program. This public kickoff meeting will be held at **Four Mile Run Park on December 20 at 6:30 p.m. near the end of Edison Street** to present the project team, details, goals and timeline. *In the event of rain, the meeting will be rescheduled and a subsequent meeting notice for the revised location and date will be distributed by the City.* Additional public meetings will be held to gather community input as the design progress. All are welcome to attend and encouraged to ask questions.

As part of the City of Alexandria’s Flood Action program, City staff and its consultant visited the neighborhood in July 2021 in response to flooding reports. Based on conversations with residents and further investigations, the City’s consultant created some concepts for mitigating flooding issues. The consultant will collect additional information on the neighborhood storm sewer system and streetscape and support the design of three overall projects: 1) Edison Street Cul-De-Sac Drainage Improvements, 2) 100 W. Reed Ave. Curb Inlets and 3) 100 Dale Rd. Overland Relief Channel. Notice to Proceed (NTP) for this design was issued on 10/17/2022. The project is funded by a grant from the Virginia Community Flood Preparedness Fund (CFPF) and the City’s Stormwater Utility Fee.

In the subsequent months, contractor teams will be onsite to perform a topographic survey and geotechnical testing. The City will provide notice before road closures and other impacts to public property. We don’t foresee any disturbances or impacts to your private property, and none would occur without prior agreement and coordination from the City. Contractor operations will adhere to existing city noise and construction ordinances: *Construction work in the City of Alexandria is permitted from 7:00 a.m. – 6:00 p.m. Monday – Friday and 9:00 a.m. – 5:00 p.m. on Saturday. No construction activity is permitted on Sundays.*

Please be mindful of contractor crews working in or alongside the roadway.
