UTILITY WORK NOTICE – APRIL 2023

100 Block of W. Reed Ave and Edison St Cul-de-Sac

This notice is to inform City of Alexandria Residents in immediate proximity of the intersection of 100 W. Reed Ave (location #1) and the Edison Street Cul-de-Sac (location #2) that boring work is scheduled to be performed in the area.

The City has hired a contractor to collect information on the City's storm sewer system and streetscape in support of the three projects which began design on October 17th, 2022.

The soil boring work is scheduled to begin and end the week of April 3rd, 2023, weather permitting. Work will occur during standard work hours and is expected to take no more than one full workday. The Contractor crews will operate drilling equipment to sample the underlying soils and confirm they are acceptable to support the proposed infrastructure. Never will contractor operations violate existing city noise and construction ordinances:

Construction work in the City of Alexandria is permitted from 7:00AM to 6:00PM Monday – Friday, and 9:00AM – 5:00PM on Saturday. No construction activity is permitted on Sundays.

No disturbances or impacts will be made to your private property.

Road closures are scheduled along and around W. Reed Ave on April 3rd through April 5th, 2023, to support these efforts. Access to residential driveways within the work area will be maintained; however, street parking within the work area will be restricted for the duration of work. Please relocate any street parked vehicles prior to the start of work. Lane closure signs will be posted the day before operations begin. No parking restrictions are anticipated to support the soil boring work near the Edison St. Cul-de-Sac.

As always, please be mindful of contractor crews working in or alongside the roadway.
