The EPC is partnering with the Chesapeake Climate Action Network (CCAN), Rewiring America & Citizens Climate Lobby to discuss how to Save Money and Fight the Climate Crisis by explaining who qualifies and how much money everyone gets back from the federal government when they replace gas appliances with electric, upgrade electrical panels (think electric vehicle charger or induction stoves), add insulation or air sealing and other measures to make your home use less gas and more efficient electricity. We'll also have some practical tips on energy auditing that you can do on your own -like how and where to caulk. Demonstrations will include induction cooktops and show you how to start turning your home into your castle - even if you rent!
