




Precincts and Polling Places

- Keep Voting Equipment Secure






Election Officer Recruitment and Training

Election Day

Election Day

- Open Office at 4:30 a.m.
- Answer Calls from Voters and Election Officers
 - Resolve complicated voter eligibility questions
 - Assist with equipment issues
- Close Polls at 7:00 p.m.
 - Post unofficial Election Results
 - Receive Equipment from Chiefs





No-Excuse Absentee Voting

- Begins 45 Days Prior to each Election
- May Vote In Person or By Mail
- Permanent Absentee
