
Four Mile Run Park Pedestrian Bridge Replacement Project



EXISTING CONDITIONS OF THE BRIDGE










The Four Mile Run Park Bridge was closed on August 12, 2021, following a certified engineer condition assessment

SCOPE OF THE PROJECT

The scope of work will include replacing the existing pedestrian bridge and constructing a section of asphalt trail to connect the bridge with the existing trial.

NEW BRIDGE

- Prefabricated weathering steel truss
- 12-foot-wide reinforced concrete deck
- Supports 30,000 lb. vehicle loads
- Riprap slope protection



CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULE

Construction is scheduled to begin by end of September 2023 and finish by the end of July 2024. General construction activities are permitted to occur Monday through Friday, 7:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m., and Saturday, 9:00 a.m. to 6:00 p.m.
