# **Key Definitions**

- Pregnancy rates vs. Number of Pregnancies
  - Rates have a numerator & a denominator
    - Control for population differences
  - Number is a count of how many events or people
- Pregnancy rate: Number of pregnancies per 1,000 females
- Live birth rate: Number of live births per 1,000 females

- Number of pregnancies:
  - # of live births
  - + # of pregnancy terminations
  - + # of natural fetal death
  - = # of pregnancies
- Teen: Person 10 to 19 years of age
- Statistical significance: calculated difference between two rates or numbers that is not likely due to chance alone

## TRENDS OVER TIME & PLACE




#### Alexandria's Teen Pregnancy Rate & Count (2019-2020)

- In 2019, there were 74 teen pregnancies in Alexandria
  - 2019 Pregnancy Rate:
    - 12.4 pregnancies per 1,000 females ages 10 to 19
- In 2020, there were 63 teen pregnancies in Alexandria
  - 2020 teen pregnancy rate:
    - 10.4 pregnancies per 1,000 females ages 10 to 19
- From 2019 to 2020 Alexandria's teen pregnancy rate declined 16.1%
  - This decline is not statistically significant




#### Alexandria's Teen Pregnancy Rate & Live Birth Rate (2005-2020)






# Teen Pregnancy Rates in NOVA & Statewide in 2020






# Teen Pregnancy Rate by Locality (2005-2020)





# Teen Pregnancy in Alexandria from 1979 to 2020



# DISPARITIES BY RACE & HISPANIC ETHNICITY




#### Alexandria Teen Pregnancy Rate by Race & Ethnicity (2005-2020)






#### Live Birth Rate Among Alexandria Teens ages 15-19 by Race & Ethnicity (2009 - 2020)

- Racial and ethnic disparities exist nationwide
- Non-Hispanic white and Non-Hispanic Asian teens have the lowest birth rates nationwide


# TRENDS AND BENCHMARKS BY AGE

# Alexandria Teen Pregnancy by Age Group

- Of the 74 teen pregnancies in Alexandria in 2019:
  - 18 (24%) were among teens 15 to 17 years of age
  - 56 (76%) were among teens 18 to 19 years of age
- Of the 63 teen pregnancies in Alexandria in 2020:
  - 23 (37%) were among teens 15 to 17 years of age
  - 40 (63%) were among teens 18 to 19 years of age




#### Alexandria Teen Pregnancy Rate by Age Group (2005 - 2020)






# Alexandria Teen Birth Rate by Age (2005-2020)




# Visits by Sub Program at the TWC in 2019 & 2020



## Youth Behavioral Risk Survey (YRBS) Data

- Based on a *preliminary analysis* of the 2019 YRBS data, we've found that:
  - A **higher** percentage of high school students reported ever having sex and currently having sex in 2019 compared to 2016
  - A **higher** percentage of middle school students reported ever having sex and currently having sex in 2019 compared to 2016 and 2014
    - Further analyses will determine if this increases are statistically significant
  - Of high school students who reported having sex, 11% reported no method was used to prevent pregnancy the last time they had sex
  - More than 50% of high school students who have ever had sex reported using a condom the last time they had sex
  - Less than 50% of middle school students who have ever had sex reported using a condom the last time they had sex

# Key Takeaways from the 2019 & 2020 Teen Pregnancy Data

- Alexandria's teen pregnancy rate declined by 16.1% from 2019 to 2020
  - This decline was not statistically significant
- Alexandria's pregnancy rates among teens ages 15 to 17 and 18 to 19 remain below the Health People 2020 benchmarks
- Alexandria's pregnancy rate among teens ages 15 to 19 is below the HP2030 target
- Disparities across race & ethnicity persist
  - Higher pregnancy rates for teens who identify as Black
  - Statically significantly higher pregnancy rates for teens who identify as Hispanic

## Next Steps

- Alexandria Health Department will continue to:
  - Strive for health equity
  - Provide patient-centered & evidence-based care that focuses on and supports teen's long-term life goals and emphasizes abstinence as the only method guaranteed to prevent pregnancy and STIs
  - Support pregnant and parenting teens through our WIC and Field Nursing programs
  - Collaborate with ACPS, SAPCA, and others to develop programs based on the 2019 YRBS data
  - Collaborate with ACPS and others to develop & administer the 2022 YRBS

## Questions & Answers from 5/18/22:

- Is demographic data collected for teen fathers?
  - Yes. Age, race, and ethnicity data is collected for teen fathers. AHD has requested additional data from VDH for analysis.
- Were there any teen pregnancies in 2019 or 2020 with a maternal age of less than 15 years?
  - No. All teen pregnancies that occurred in Alexandria in 2019 and 2020 were among mothers 15-19 years of age.
- Did more than 50% of high school and middle school students who completed the 2019 YRBS indicate that they were currently having or had ever had sexual intercourse?
  - No. Although there was an increase in the percentage of YRBS respondents who reported currently having sex and ever having sex, the majority of respondents reported never having sex.
