Committed Affordable Rental Housing Options

Within the City of Alexandria, Virginia public and private owners of rental housing offer a variety of committed affordable housing options for low- and moderate-income residents through participation in local, state, and/or federal programs. These units are available to income-eligible households and some programs give priority or restrict admission to specific populations, such as elderly or residents with disabilities.

For mental health, intellectual and physical disability and substance abuse services and associated housing, please contact the Department of Community and Human Services (DCHS) at 703.746.5700. Please note that most DCHS programs and services have been consolidated at the Del Pepper Community Center at 4850 Mark Center Drive, Alexandria, VA 22311.

A. Public Housing and the Housing Choice Voucher Program

The Alexandria Redevelopment and Housing Authority (ARHA) owns and manages public housing and select mixed-income housing in the City of Alexandria. ARHA also administers the federal Housing Choice Voucher program (formerly known as the Section 8 program). Both programs have waitlists maintained by ARHA. As of July 2024, both waitlists are closed.

ARHA owns approximately 1,100 rental units, including apartments, townhouses, and condominium units located throughout the city. Public housing residents pay for their housing based on adjusted household income.

ARHA also administers the Federal Housing Choice Voucher (HCV) rental subsidy program on behalf of the City. HCV holders receive assistance to rent privately-owned housing. As of July 2020, all rental properties with four or more units in the State of Virginia

are required to treat HCVs as income when evaluating a rental application.

B. Privately Owned, Federally Subsidized Housing

The apartment complexes listed below participate in federal programs that are subsidized such that eligible households only pay 30% of their gross income for rent. The subsidy is assigned to the unit and is available only while the individual or family lives at that property. Households cannot take the rental subsidy with them if they move. These programs are administered directly by properties and interested persons should contact each property individually for information on availability or waitlists.
