WHAT IS SYEP?

SYEP is the Summer Youth Employment Program, managed by the Workforce Development Center (WDC), TeensWork! and Youth Employment Services (YES) and is designed to help youth ages 14-21 in the City of Alexandria obtain and retain employment year-round. YES, Summer Youth Program will serve the City of Alexandria youth through an in-person 6 week workforce development experience from June 26 through August 3, 2023.


APPLIED LEARNING






DEMOGRAPHICS

ANSWERED BY 118 SUMMER YOUTH PARTICIPANTS




