

On December 14, 2023, the Department of Planning & Zoning hosted a Walking Tour for our City Colleagues of architecture within the Old and Historic Alexandria District (Old Town), newer architecture on development sites that are redeveloped or are under the implementation phase of the Old Town North Small Area Plan updated in 2018, and recently redeveloped areas of the Waterfront pursuant to the Waterfront Overlay Plan adopted in 2012.
