

Holmes Run Trail Repairs


- Site #4 (4600 Duke/Jordan St.) is complete and open for use
- Sites #2 and #3 are in construction procurement, anticipated to be open
 Spring/Summer 2025
- Site #1 is in design and will be coordinated with grant funding, anticipated to be open in 2026

Four Mile Run Park Trail Bridge Replacement

- Landside construction is near completion, the bridge is expected to be installed in January 2024
- Substantial completion is anticipated mid to late March 2024

Trails Update

Current approved Capital Facility Maintenance for Trails

- Funding for trail maintenance and repairs
- FY 2024-FY 2033 Approved CIP includes \$150,000 every 2-3 years
- FY 2024 Projects include: Mount Vernon Trail Repairs (East Abingdon and Oronoco Segments), Mount Jefferson Trail Repairs (Stewart Avenue), Holmes Run Trail Repairs (Chambliss Extension), Eisenhower Trail Repairs

Planned Trail CIP Projects

- Armistead Boothe Park/Linear Park Trail Extension (FY 2025)
- Dora Kelley Park Fair-Weather Crossing Replacement (FY 2025) (Holmes Run Trail Repairs Site #1)



Trails Update

Pavement Condition Assessment

- Conducted every three years
- Next assessment anticipated in 2025
- Coordinated with the road network assessment
- Creates objective and quantifiable data for trail prioritization

- Additional information to be available this spring




2022 Trail Condition Assessment





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Action Item: DRPT Grants



FY 2025 Virginia Department of Rail and Public Transportation (DRPT) State Aid Request

Operating Assistance (up to \$37,000,000)

- State awards a portion for general operating expenses
- Typically, 20-30% reimbursement
- Avg: \$5m Annually

Capital Assistance (up to \$400,000)

- Hybrid Spare Parts (Powertrain & Battery Replacements)
- Typically, 60-68% reimbursement
- Avg: \$4m Annually

Commuter Assistance Program (up to \$350,000)

- Go Alex staffing and programming
- 20% local match required

Demonstration Projects (up to \$300,000) - DASH

- Onboard Passenger Information Screen Pilot
- "Thru Vision" Blindspot Camera Pilot
- 20% local match required

Public Transport. Workforce Development (up to \$110,000) - DASH

- 2 Interns
- 20% local match required

Transit Rider Incentive Program (Up to \$500,000)

- Improving bus stops with shelters, benches, ADA improvements, etc.
- 32% local match required



Regional Roadway Safety Program (RRSP)


- Planning and preliminary engineering
- Roadway safety issues to reduce fatal and serious injury crashes.
- Up to \$80,000 in short-term consultant services
- Applications are due March 8, 2024
- If awarded, work starts Fall 2024
- Work to be completed by June 30, 2025




