



Checklist for Power-On/ Power-Up Programs

All campers should bring an extra change of clothes, reuseable water bottle and backpack, labeled with their name each day.

All registration, medical, and release forms must be completed and submitted to your preferred location by May 24.

Camp Payment

The program registration fee is due at the time of registration. Financial Assistance and Payment Plan options are available upon request. All balances must be paid by the end of the summer program.

ADA Accomodations

The Department of Recreation, Parks & Cultural Activities is committed to providing innovative, inclusive, accessible, and affordable programs, which enhance the health, well-being, and quality of life for Alexandria residents with all abilities. All ADA requests must be submitted 2 weeks prior to the start of the preferred class, program, camp, or event.

OSTP Standard Operating Procedures

Power-On and Power-Up are not licensed child care programs, but both programs are based on local standards. Each location's program is planned to be ageappropriate and properly supervised. Local standards are available online at alexandriava.gov/Recreation.



Medical Information

The Out of School Time Power-On/ Power-Up program does not administer any medication.

With written authorization from a parent or guardian and signed by the child's physician, inhalers and EpiPens needed for life-threatening medical conditions are permissible in the original labeled containers and will be held in a secured location in the program office. Staff will take these medications to any program activities offsite in a medical backpack with other standard first aid supplies.

Any other medication requests are handled on a case-by-case basis.
