## Question:

The state budget approach to the At-Risk Add On reduces funding for ACPS in that category overall. That reduction is likely related to the decision to follow the JLARC recommendation to combine the At-Risk Add On program funding with the funding from the Prevention, Intervention, and Remediation program and run them through an updated formula. What is the fiscal impact of that change to ACPS?

## Response:
