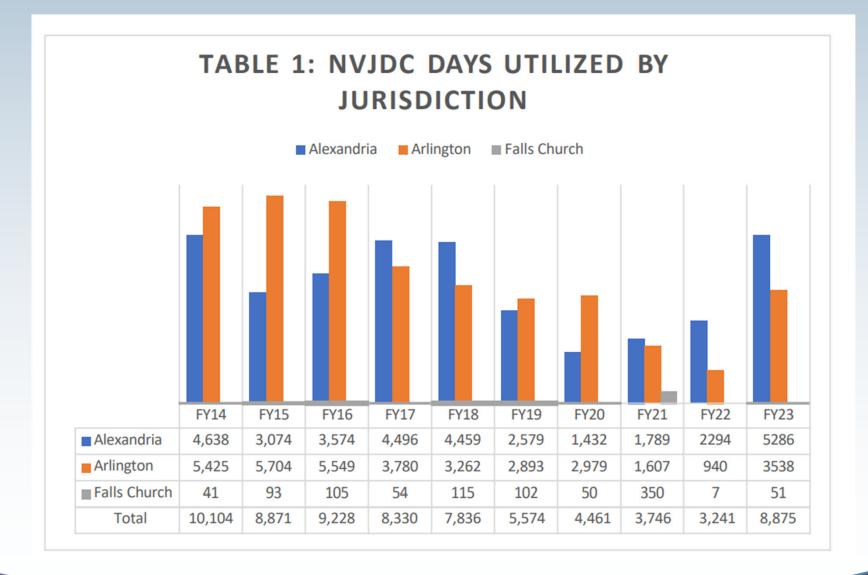


Public Safety Prior Year Investments – FY 2022-24

NVJDC FY 2025 Budget Request

- Total expenditures = \$5.8 M (\$0.8 M, or 16% increase)
- Jurisdictions' share = \$4.2 M (\$0.9 M, or 28% increase)
- City share = \$2.5 M (\$0.9 M, or 57% increase)
 - \$0.46 M due to change in utilization
 - \$0.20 M due to prior year credit
 - \$0.25 M due to cost increases
- City proposed budget = \$2.2 M (\$0.26 M less than NVJDC budget)



Sheltercare FY 2025 Budget Request

- Total proposed expenditures = \$2.3 M (\$0.8 M, or 54% increase)
 - 93% of increase due to personnel costs
 - Assumes 6% pay increases and 0% vacancies
- City share = \$2.1 M (\$0.8 M or 61% increase)
- City proposed budget = \$1.8 M (\$0.3 M, or 27% increase)
 - \$0.49 M less than Sheltercare request
 - Assumes 6% pay increases and current vacancy rate



Public Safety – FY 2025

Fire Department

- Fire Recruit School: \$275,075 (p. 14.37)
- Professional Standards: \$160,000 (p.14.37)
- CERT Volunteer Management: \$106,729 (p.14.37)
- Promotional Process: \$230,000 (p.14.38)

- Fees last increased July 2021
- Additional revenue projected: \$1.1M



Public Safety – FY 2025

Police Department and Sheriff's Office

- Joint Sheriff & Police Cadet Pilot: \$100,000 (p.11.90), (p.14.64)
- Northern Virginia Criminal Justice Acad. \$270,164 (p. 14.55)
- Additional Penny: 1.0 Sheriff's Deputy position \$100,000 (Slide 25 – proposed budget presentation)
- Public Safety Technology Initiative (CIP, p.14.59)
 - Real Time Information Center (accountability, transparency and community safety enhancements)
 - Coordinating across public safety agencies



Other Items – FY 2025

- Public Defender's Office: 1.0 Paralegal \$64,379 (p.14.55)
- Circuit Court Judges/ITS: BWC technology support -\$97,290 (p.11.63) (p.14.4)
- Drug Treatment Court Funding: \$120,000 (p.14.14)
- Independent Policing Auditor: 2.0 positions (investigative/policy analyst & management analyst): \$288,978 (p. 11.59)
- Virginia Alcohol Safety Action Program (VASAP): \$100,000 (p.14.55)
