Agenda:

- Call to Order: Chair Friedlander called the meeting to order at 7:01 p.m. with a quorum present. Chair Friedlander introduced two new BFAAC members: Nancy Drane, the School Board Representative and Brant Snyder, a Citizen At-Large. Chair Friedlander shared some information with BFAAC members from a Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) training she recently attended.
- 2. Approval of the Minutes from the January 30, 2024, meeting: A motion was made by MacNamara and seconded by Williams to approve the minutes of the January 30th BFAAC meeting. The motion was carried by unanimous vote.
- 3. City Manager's Proposed 2025 Operating Budget and FY 2025-FY 2034 Capital Improvement Program Presentation: BFAAC members watched the City Manager's Presentation to the City Council of the Proposed 2025 Operating Budget and FY 2025-FY 2034 Capital Improvement Program. Chair Friedlander asked BFAAC Members to pay attention to the messaging.

4. BFAAC Workplan Items: Observations on the City Manager's Proposed Budget

BFAAC Members discussed the City Manager's Budget and agreed on the following topic areas for the budget memo:

- Impact of the School Board's budget request to be drafted by **Drane**.
- CIP sustainability to be drafted by MacNamara.
- Commercial/residential real estate tax revenue trend to be drafted by Friedlander.
- City Manager budget presentation messaging to be drafted by **Friedlander**.

Chair Friedlander asked for BFAAC member input on each of these sections by March 18.

- 5. Ad Hod Stormwater Committee Report: Ferrara reported that the AD Hoc Stormwater Committee has not yet met in March.
- 6. **OMB Report: Routt** reminded BFAAC of the important dates in the City Council's budget review process and stated that the BFAAC could present to the Council on March 20th or April 3rd. **Chair Friedlander** recommended April 3rd as the next BFAAC meeting is March 19th and it would enable BFAAC to provide the memo to Council prior to the meeting.
