Chairman Powers called the January 13, 2025, meeting to order at 9:30 a.m. Present were the three members of the Alexandria Electoral Board (Jack Powers, Bruce A. Brown, and Tom Fulton); the General Registrar (Angie Maniglia Turner); and the Elections Manager (Mark Hirschman).

This was Mr. Brown's first meeting in his sixth term on the Electoral Board. On behalf of the board, Mr. Fulton extended his congratulations to Ms. Maniglia Turner for her completion of the renewal of her Certified Elections Registration Administrator (CERA) certificate.

Previous Minutes

Mr. Fulton moved to approve the minutes from the December 10, 2024 meeting; Mr. Brown seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously.

Election Office Report

Ms. Maniglia Turner updated the Electoral Board on the office's registration numbers, absentee applications, and campaign finance reports. Also discussed were the upcoming annual appointments for Officers of Election and proposed bills for the General Assembly legislative session. Since the last board meeting, City Council did approve the ordinance to open Beatley Library as a satellite voting site for all primary elections.

George Mason Polling Place

Ms. Maniglia Turner presented available options the Electoral Board for the temporary replacement to George Mason Elementary School during renovations. Mr. Fulton made a motion to forward the Trinity United Methodist Church to City Council; Mr. Brown seconded the motion, and it passed unanimously. During discussion, Mr. Brown recommended that the precinct name be temporarily changed to "Trinity Precinct" to help voters. The Church does not want campaign signs to be posted on their property, but they understand the requirements to allow campaigning on Election Day. A ramp will need to be procured to make the entrance ADA compliant.
