- 1. Vote to approve February retreat minutes**
  - a. Motion to approve by Eleanor Q, Seconded by Maralyn; Passed unanimously*
- 2. Discussion of updated advocacy letter re: transitioning to electric leaf blowers**
  - a. The key change from versions previously shown to the ABC was in the addition of recommendation of an education campaign, alternatives to blowing leaves & a prompt transition.
  - b. A spirited discussion followed with questions from Alisa and Kevin. Suggestions were made about future Zebra articles on what kinds of blowers to buy and why to leave the leaves.
  - c. Eleanor Q presented about advocacy around Leave the Leaves.
  - d. Motion to approve signing onto the letter by Kenneth, Seconded by Russ; Passed unanimously*
- 3. Discussion of thank you breakfast for refuse collectors**
  - a. Eleanor T gave an update on discussion of hosting a thank you breakfast for refuse collectors.
  - b. The goal is to annually recognize different kinds of workers who contribute to beautification of the city.
  - c. Daniya asked about format. It was historically a pancake breakfast, however could be coffee and bagels for 70 people.

- d. A discussion of timing followed. Several members of the group shared concerns about getting donations on a short timeline.
  - e. The conversation was tabled until after we get alternate dates that could work besides 3/28.
4. **Reports from each subcommittee based on retreat goals.**
- a. Kelsey reported on updates from the Awards Committee:
    - i. Key dates to save for 2025, including the nomination form, van tour and awards ceremony.
    - ii. Key changes to criteria, including: streamlining overall criteria, changing the timeframe in which an award could be nominated after last winning to 7 years, residential street award and no longer requiring a set number of awards.
    - iii. She explained the updated categories, including 1. Community (to include public art & architecture), 2. Residential, and 3. Residential Street.
    - iv. *Motion to approve by Eleanor Q; Seconded by multiple members; Passed unanimously*
  - b. Daniya gave an update on Education. Since many members were unable to make the retreat, the Education Committee will report out later.
    - i. Starting next month, Emily will take over Zebra articles, while Daniya will manage social media accounts
    - ii. ABC members are asked to share ideas for content on art, sustainability, interesting community events, and more.
    - iii. Sara shared timing and structure for Zebra articles.
  - c. The Advocacy Committee took turns presenting on their 10 Advocacy Committee SMART goals (see handout shared separately).
5. **Other updates**
- a. Eleanor T spoke about the ACPS Native Roots project; a planting kickoff is planned for on Earth Day, Tuesday, April 22 @ John Adams Elementary School/Early Childhood Center (ECC).
  - b. Oscar shared that the city has now hired two Natural Resource Managers
  - c. Eleanor T gave an update about Alexandria High School student Harlow Barbic who is the leader for the Watershed Warriors & will be completing an internship with us. Eleanor setting up shadowing opportunities for her.
  - d. Liz set up 2 **Native Plants Seminars** with Beatley Library on [Saturday, April 26](#) and [Thursday, May 1](#); ABC members are encouraged to spread the word and attend.
  - e. After discussion and a vote, the ABC determined to participate in the following spring events. Members are asked to sign up for tabling shifts:
