CONDOMINIUM UNIT RENOVATIONS

A condominium (condo) unit owner has the right to make improvements and alterations within their own unit but must do so in accordance with the condo association's governing documents. In addition, the owner must meet all requirements of the Virginia Construction Code and obtain all required permits from the City of Alexandria.

All renovations that propose a modification of: the building structural system (load-bearing elements such as floor/ceiling assembly, beams/girders, bearing/shear walls, columns, etc.), exit access pathways, or increase the fire hazard (changes to fire-resistance rating assemblies, fire protection systems, storage of hazardous materials, etc.) are required to be prepared by a Virginia registered design professional (RDP), which can be a registered Architect or Professional Engineer.). Furthermore, any upgrade to electrical panelboards necessitates an analysis of the entire building's electrical system conducted by a registered electrical engineer, which specifies the maximum allowable ampacity for the panelboards in the dwelling units.

- One alternative to stamped and sealed plans by an RDP is to have a signed and sealed letter from an RDP, stating that alteration work will be conducted under his/her supervision.
- For limited alteration work (such as bathroom renovation involving changes to corridor walls assembly), RDP-signed and sealed documents are not required when an altered wall assembly detail drawing is indicated on plans.
- Please note that all new penetrations through existing floor or wall structures shall be protected by listed fire-stop systems, which should be presented on plans submitted for the building permit.

What can be replaced in a Condominium unit without obtaining a City of Alexandria building permit?

- Replacement of plumbing fixtures without the alteration of the water supply and distribution systems, sanitary drainage systems, or vent systems.
- Replacement of electrical appliances/water heaters with similar appliances/equipment.
- Installation or replacement of wall/floor finishes.
- Installation of replacement cabinetry or trim.
- Other repair work deemed by the building official to be minor and ordinary which does not adversely affect public health or general safety.

To apply for a building permit the construction documents and permit application shall be uploaded into APEX - City of Alexandria review portal.
