I think much like how the sports courts are being considered for expansion, the parkour space should be considered for future expansion into the open lawn as well or instead.

Separate areas for toddlers (2-5) and older children (5-12) to ensure safety and appropriate challenges, using gentle gradations in elevation or low hedges, logs, or fences to define zones without enclosing them harshly. Include shaded seating around the perimeter for caregivers with clear sightlines to both age zones. Install a mix of climbing structures, swings (including bucket and accessible swings), and slides. Include ground-level features like sensory panels, drums, spinners, and crawl-throughs. Provide ramps and transfer stations so children with mobility limitations can access elevated elements. Consider a storytelling circle or amphitheater-style seating for reading events or performances. Install low fencing (if needed) to define the space and prevent children from wandering away from play area. Provide clear signage about age groups, supervision guidelines, and hours of use. Provide wide paths for wheelchairs and strollers. Include inclusive seesaws, sensory paths, and quiet zones for children who might get overstimulated. Use contrasting colors and textures to help children with visual impairments navigate. Restrooms should be nearby.

I would extend it out from the shaded picnic/awning area and continue that theme just make is able to be weight bearing. How often is the skatepark used?
