

Project Location & Background

- Located along the 3800 block of Edison Street in the Hume Springs Park neighborhood
- Outfalls to an unnamed tributary of Four Mile Run
- Storm sewer system capacity is insufficient during heavy storms
- Flood depth along Edison street exceeds the 6" curb height



Location

Project Goals


- ✓ Reduce flooding along Edison Street through the installation of new pipes and inlets
- ✓ Convey the City's standard design storm (10-year) within the City's public right-of-way
- ✓ Mitigate flood impacts from larger storm events as much as possible.
- Verify that upstream improvements do not adversely impact downstream properties

Upgrade pipes and inlets




Approved Design

- Vertical relocation of Water Main on Edison St. by Virginia American Water Company
- Abandon gas main on Edison St. and install new gas main in west alley by Washington Gas



Project Performance




- 1. Flooding within the cul-desac is contained within the right-of-way
- 2. Flooding in the open space area east of the project site is resolved
- 3. Flooding in the open space area west of the project site is reduced
- 4. Flooding along the 3600 block is reduced and contained within the right-of-way




Temporary Impacts: Access & Parking

Work Limits

- Overnight parking restrictions will be required
- Restrictions will be phased
- Overflow parking will be provided at Four Mile Run Park
- Portions of Four Mile Run
 Park will be closed
- Trash & recycling pick-up will continue
