
CYCP GOAL AND STRATEGIC AREA


In this pie chart, when it comes to drop outs, only 6.2% of students Advance dropped out while the others got their diploma at a 53.7%

PERFORMANCE EFFORT - -


- ACPS has created an strategic called "Equity For All 2025" where they plan on which outlines their commitment to ensuring all students, regardless of background, have access to a quality education

PERFORMANCE EFFECT

- 87% of seniors from Class of 2024, and one of the biggest graduates in 10 years has graduated from ACHS.
- The possible effect if we continue to follow the strategic plan could potentially increase the graduating rates above 80% if students attend to school to gather their educational materials, Students have full support if they have difficulties prior to what specific level of their education they don't understand. If we avoid this problem the solution wont be in affect and will lead to students missing school, not doing their assignments, possible dropouts, not reaching credit requirements, etc.
