6. City Information Technology Services Updates (Steve Chozick)

- City Hall renovation project. Involves several office moves, expected to take approximately three years.
- Fiscal Year 2026 began July 1, 2025. Next budget process is about to begin. The Commission can write letters of support for initiatives.

Not at this point, but it may in the future.

- There is a federal mandate for government websites to come into compliance with WCAG 2.1 standards as of April 2026.
- Municipal fiber project: In testing phase, expecting to accept it in late August. About 12-18 months to go-live (setting up NOC, locate/restoration contracts, etc.)

Comcast cable contract renegotiation is due in October 2026.
